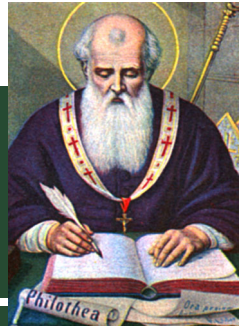

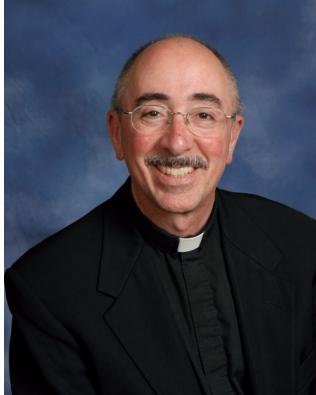

JUNE IS DEVOTED TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

"The Beloved Disciple of the Sacred Heart", St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, of the Visitation Order, was gifted with many visitations of Our Lord, presenting Himself as the Crucified one or the Ecce Homo. Our Lord acted as her spiritual advisor and in 1672, requested she establish the devotion to His Sacred Heart. Margaret Mary was also inspired by Christ to establish the Holy Hour and to pray lying prostrate on the ground from eleven until midnight the eve of the first Friday of every month. Christ made known to Margaret Mary His ardent desire to be loved by men and His design of manifesting His Heart with all its treasures of love and mercy, of sanctification and salvation. Christ appointed the Friday after the octave of the feast of Corpus Christi as the feast of the Sacred Heart.

Please consider joining us for 7 a.m. Mass the first Friday of the month to pray in reparation for the sins against the Sacred Heart of Jesus and to renew your consecration to the Sacred Heart.

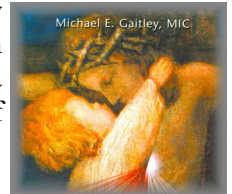
