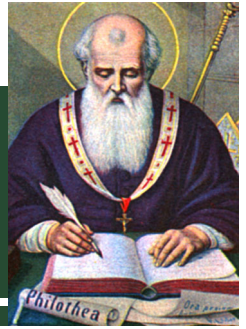

(Luke 9:57b) The Church today more than ever needs dedicated individuals willing to make the commitment to follow Christ in roles of service and leadership. Thank God for the young people who are answering the call to serve the Church as priests, deacons, religious and lay ministers!

This summer, we are again blessed to have the presence of our seminarian intern, John Baumgardner, for the summer. John is a seminarian of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee studying theology in Rome, and lives at the North American College. 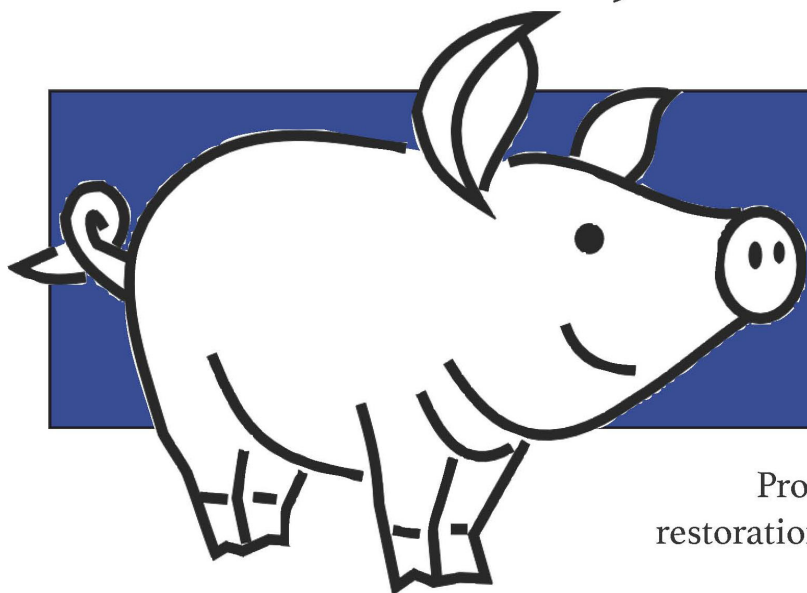

St. Benedict Parish invites you to attend our mission given by Father Ben Cameron from the Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy.
