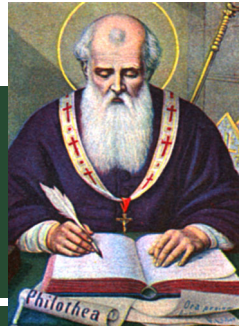

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Francis de Sales Parish,

Today's Gospel focuses on the teaching, "You shall love the Lord your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your being, with all your strength, and all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." Jesus illustrates this teaching with the parable of the Good Samaritan.

A man, who had been beaten and robbed, was left to die on the road. The people in the parable who encounter him on the road represent different approaches to religion. A priest and a Levite pass him by without offering help as they make their way to the temple. They represent an empty religiosity, fulfilling the laws and norms of temple worship while ignoring the importance of acting justly and helping another person in his need.

The Samaritan, who rescues the wounded man and cares for him, has a living faith that shows itself in works of compassion and mercy. His faith is not simply a matter of pious practices, but one which leads him to acts of justice and love. The Good Samaritan understands the teaching, "Love your neighbor." The Gospel teaches us that the "neighbor" may be found among the poor, the oppressed, the sick, the very old, the very young, and the strangers. They are all in need of our love, our understanding and our help. May this Year of Mercy inspire us to reach out to those in need!

Queridos Miembros de la Parroquia de San Francisco de Sales,

En el Evangelio de hoy, hemos escuchado una enseñanza sobre la ley más importante: "Amarás al Señor tu Dios, con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma, con todas tus fuerzas y con todo tu ser, y a tu prójimo como a ti mismo." Jesús nos explica esta enseñanza usando la parábola del Buen Samaritano.

Las personas en la parábola no representan a individuos concretos sino representan distintas actitudes en cuanto de la fe. El levita y el sacerdote, que no ayudan al hombre dejado medio muerte en la calle, representan la religiosidad vacía. Entienden su fe como cumplimiento de normas y reglamentos de pureza externa. Cumplen bien con los preceptos cúltricos, pero no entienden la importancia de vivir la solidaridad y la justicia.

El Buen Samaritano representa la religiosidad difusa de los que practican la misericordia, la compasión y el perdón. Personas así tienen una fe viva, que se muestra no solo con palabras, sino con obras de justicia y amor. El Buen Samaritano es el que entiende la ley "Amarás a tu prójimo" y entiende que la palabra "prójimo" representa a los pobres, a los oprimidos, a los enfermos, a los menos válidos, a los ancianos, a los niños, a los extranjeros - a todos que necesitan amor, comprensión, y apoyo. ¡Que este año de Misericordia nos inspire a ayudar a los demás en sus necesidades!

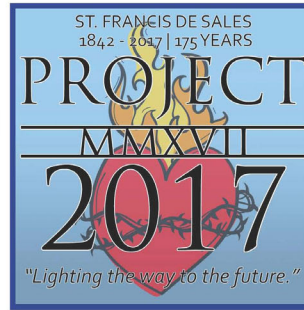
BIG CASH RAFFLE

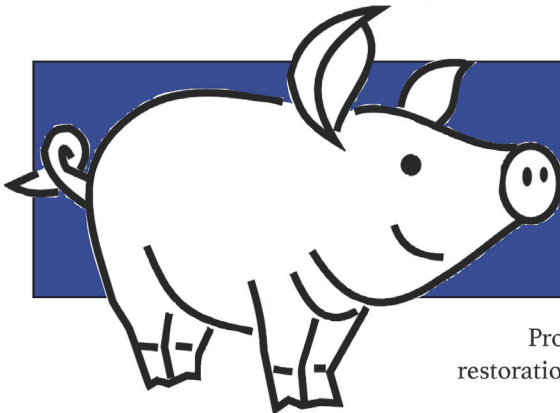
