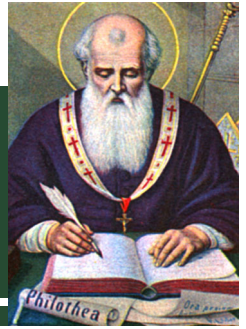

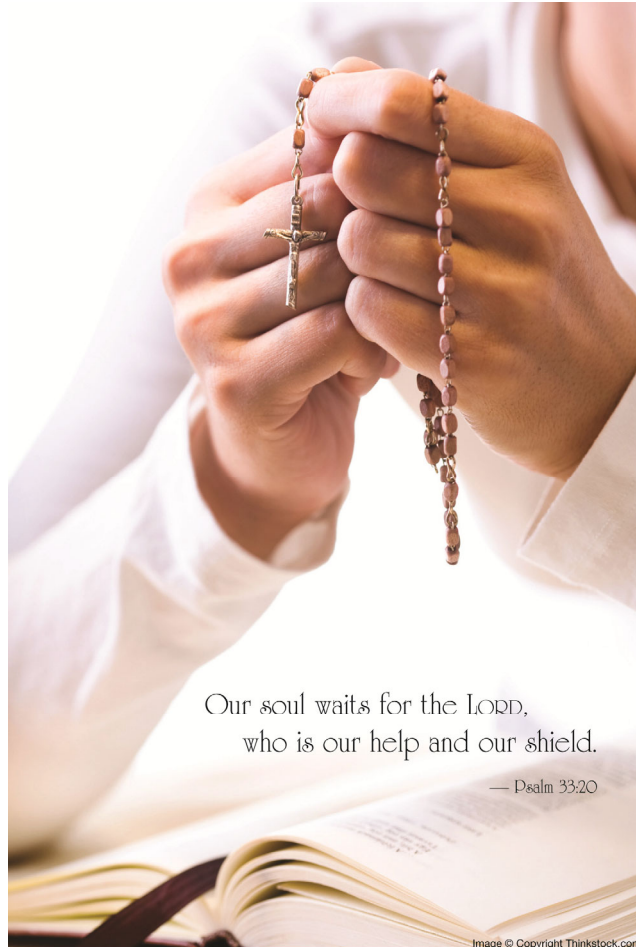

We are proud to have worked with so many fine people who shared their time and talent in a worthwhile project. 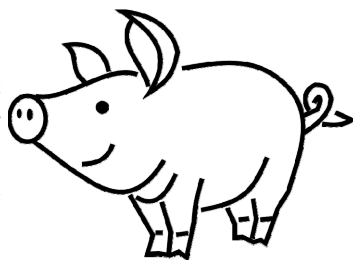
