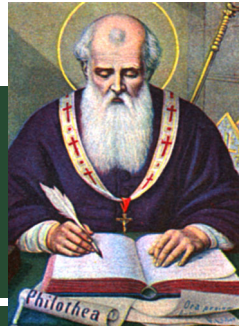

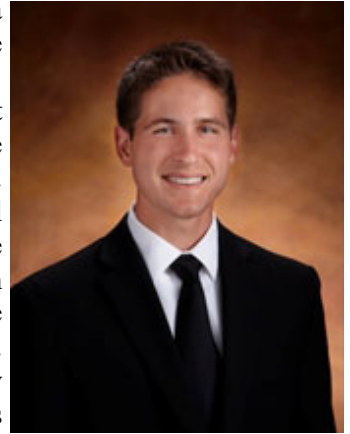

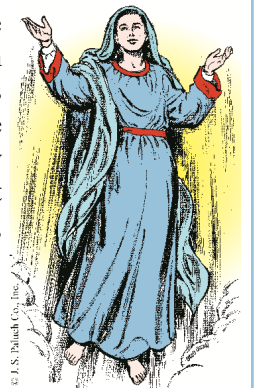

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Francis de Sales Parish,
Tomorrow, Monday, Aug. 15, is the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is normally a holy day of obligation, although when it falls on a Monday, the obligation is lifted. It is a day on which we celebrate with the whole Church what our loving God did for Mary, the Mother of his only begotten Son. God willed that the Mother of Christ should not undergo the corruption of death, but that she be assumed into the glory of heaven. This solemnity is both an opportunity to honor Mary, the Mother of our Savior, and a time to reflect on what God will do for all those who accept his will as Mary did.

Mary is the Model of the Church. She is the one who shows us how to live the Christian life. She answered "yes" to God's call, and proclaimed herself the handmaid of the Lord. True discipleship entails faithful acceptance of God's will, and a willingness to serve God always. Mary's Assumption gives us a glimpse of what God has in store for those who love and serve him – eternal happiness in his loving presence.

There will be three opportunities to attend Mass tomorrow at our parish on Monday, Aug. 15 on the Solemnity of the Assumption: 7:00 a.m., 9:00 a.m., and 7:00 p.m.
