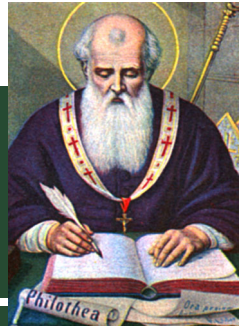

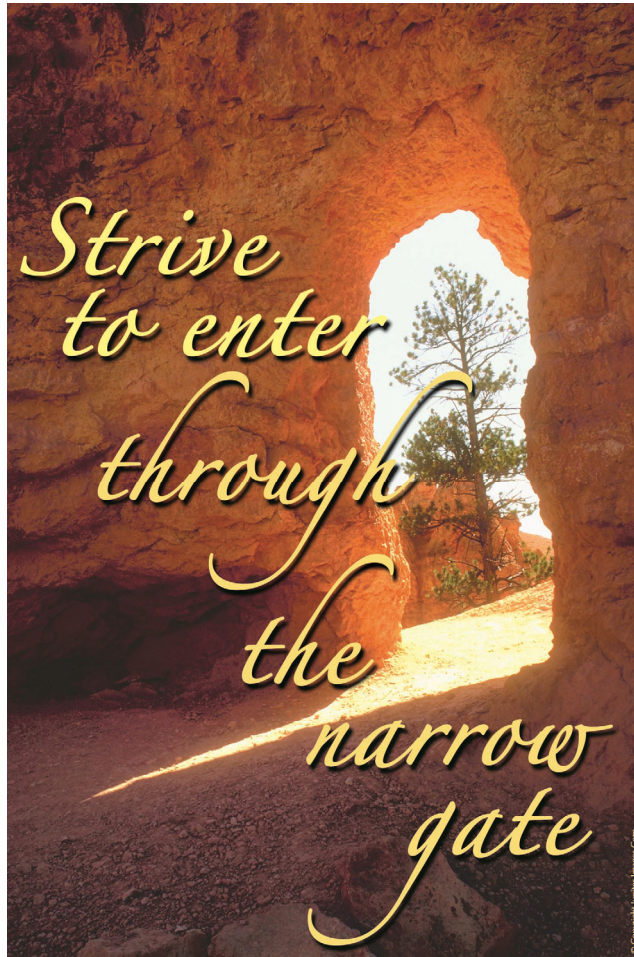

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Francis de Sales Parish,

Why do we as Christians gather for worship on Sundays? We do so because Christ rose from the dead on the first day of the week. For us, Sunday is the "Lord's Day."

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has put out a booklet with the title "A Vision for the Future: Evangelization and the Sunday Mass." The booklet states: "For Christians, every Sunday is an opportunity for intimacy, friendliness and joy. Sunday is our day to leave behind weekday routines and rejoice together in the risen Christ. In Scripture, the Acts of the Apostles describes the very first Christian community gathering on the Lord's Day to dedicate themselves to "the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to breaking of the bread and the prayers" (2:42)."

The booklet emphasizes three guiding principles: 1. "Sunday Is Our Day;" 2. "Hospitality is Our Joy;" 3. "Companionship is our Call." The first principle, "Sunday Is Our Day" focuses on the liturgy as the "source and summit" of our Christian lives and the need for parishes to encourage full and active participation of all the faithful. The second, "Hospitality Is Our Joy," emphasizes creating a welcoming environment in which all individuals and families feel included. The third, "Companionship Is Our Call," focuses on the relational dimension of Sunday worship, and the need to provide opportunities for people to deepen their relationship "with Jesus and his Church."

It is a joy to be the pastor of a parish that worships so well on Sunday. I pray that we continue to strive to create a joyful, welcoming community of faith!

Queridos Miembros de la Parroquia de San Francisco de Sales,

¿Por qué nosotros los cristianos nos congregamos los domingos para celebrar la misa? Porque Cristo resucitó en el primer día de la semana, el domingo. Para nosotros, el domingo es el "Día del Señor."

La Arquidiócesis de Milwaukee ha publicado un folleto que se llama "Una Visión para el Futuro: La Evangelización y la Misa Dominical." El folleto dice: "Para los cristianos, cada domingo es una oportunidad de intimidad, de amistad y de alegría. El domingo es nuestro día para dejar atrás la rutina de la semana y regocijarnos juntos en Cristo resucitado. En las Escrituras, los Hechos de los Apóstoles describe a la primera comunidad cristiana reuniéndose en el día del Señor para dedicarse a "la enseñanza de lo apóstoles, a la convivencia, a la fracción del pan y a las oraciones" (2:42)".

El folleto enfatiza tres principios: 1. "El Domingo Es Nuestro Día"; 2. "La Hospitalidad es Nuestro Gozo"; 3. "El Compañerismo Es Nuestro Llamado". El primer principio, "El Domingo Es Nuestro Día", se enfoca en la liturgia como "la fuente y la cumbre" de la vida cristiana, y la necesidad de animar a todos a una "participación plena, consciente y activa" en la liturgia. El segundo, "La Hospitalidad Es Nuestro Gozo", enfatiza la necesidad de crear un ambiente acogedor, donde todos se sienten en su casa. El tercero, "El Compañerismo Es Nuestro Llamado", se enfoca en la dimensión relacional de la liturgia, y la necesidad de ofrecerle a la gente oportunidades para profundizar su relación "con Jesús y su Iglesia."

¡Me alegro ser párroco de una parroquia que celebra bien los domingos! Pido al Señor que continuemos luchando para crear una comunidad de fe alegre y acogedora.
