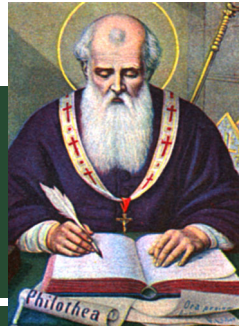

## PARISH LIBRARY NEWS

On Sept. 23, we celebrate the life of an extraordinary saint—Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, or best known as Padre Pio. He had the ability to read the hearts of penitents before they had said a word in the confessional. At the age of 31, he received the stigmata, the visible marks of the crucifixion. He possessed other unusual qualities, such as bilocation, miraculous cures, and remarkable conversions.

**Padre Pio: The True Story** - This author combed through correspondences, interviews and other research to present a well-documented biography of Padre Pio. Presents many miracles and Pio's supernatural capabilities in full detail.

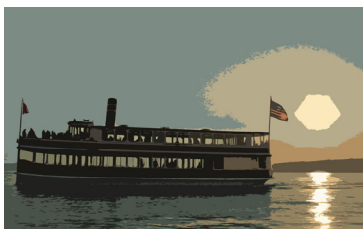
