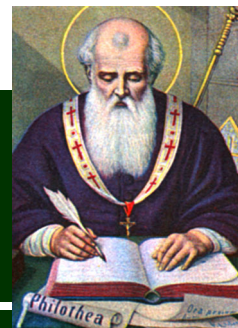

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS®

The Knights of Columbus were founded 135 years ago by a Catholic priest, Fr. Michael McGivney, in New Haven, CT. It is the largest lay Catholic organization in America, Europe and Asia with a current membership of 2 million Knights.

Did you know that the Knights were responsible for adding the words “under God” to the Pledge of Allegiance? The Knights provided prosthetic arms and legs to every child in Haiti who was injured as a result of the 2010 devastating earthquake. There are almost 1 million abortions in the US every year but only 22,000 adoptions. The Knights Ultrasound Initiative has funded more than 800 ultrasound machines in North America and it is estimated that each machine saves 4 babies a week! The Knights gave \$177.5 million in charitable donations and volunteered 75 million hours in 2016. Just recently, your Lake Geneva Knights sent in a check for \$2100 to assist in hurricane Harvey and Irma relief efforts. Thank you for your donations that added to this total.

In 2015-2016, KCs awarded \$1.93 million in scholarships to 651 college students. Most recipients are children of Knights working towards bachelor degrees at Catholic colleges and universities. This figure also includes \$327,500 in scholarship grants to 131 seminarians in the US and Canada.

SFDS HAS A HEARING LOOP

Do you wear hearing aids? Be sure to ask your audiologist if your hearing aids can be programmed for a “T-Coil”. As part of the Project 2017 Renovation, we have installed “hearing loops” in the floors of both the chapel and the church.



What does this mean? You should be able to push a button or move a switch on your hearing aid (your audiologist will need to program but most times it’s already built in) so that the sound will be picked up directly by your hearing aid to give you better clarity.

If your hearing aids are not compatible, ask one of the ushers to borrow one of our hand held loop receivers with headphones during Mass. This will take advantage of the same technology. If you have used this system before, it will be easy for you! If you have hearing aids but don’t know about the t-coil, **ask your audiologist** if you can take advantage of this technology. You probably have seen this sign at theaters and auditoriums...It’s the international sign to let people know that there is a hearing loop in the building. This logo is now at all of our church entrances and in our church bulletin to let visitors know that they can tune in!
