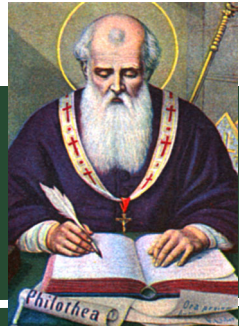

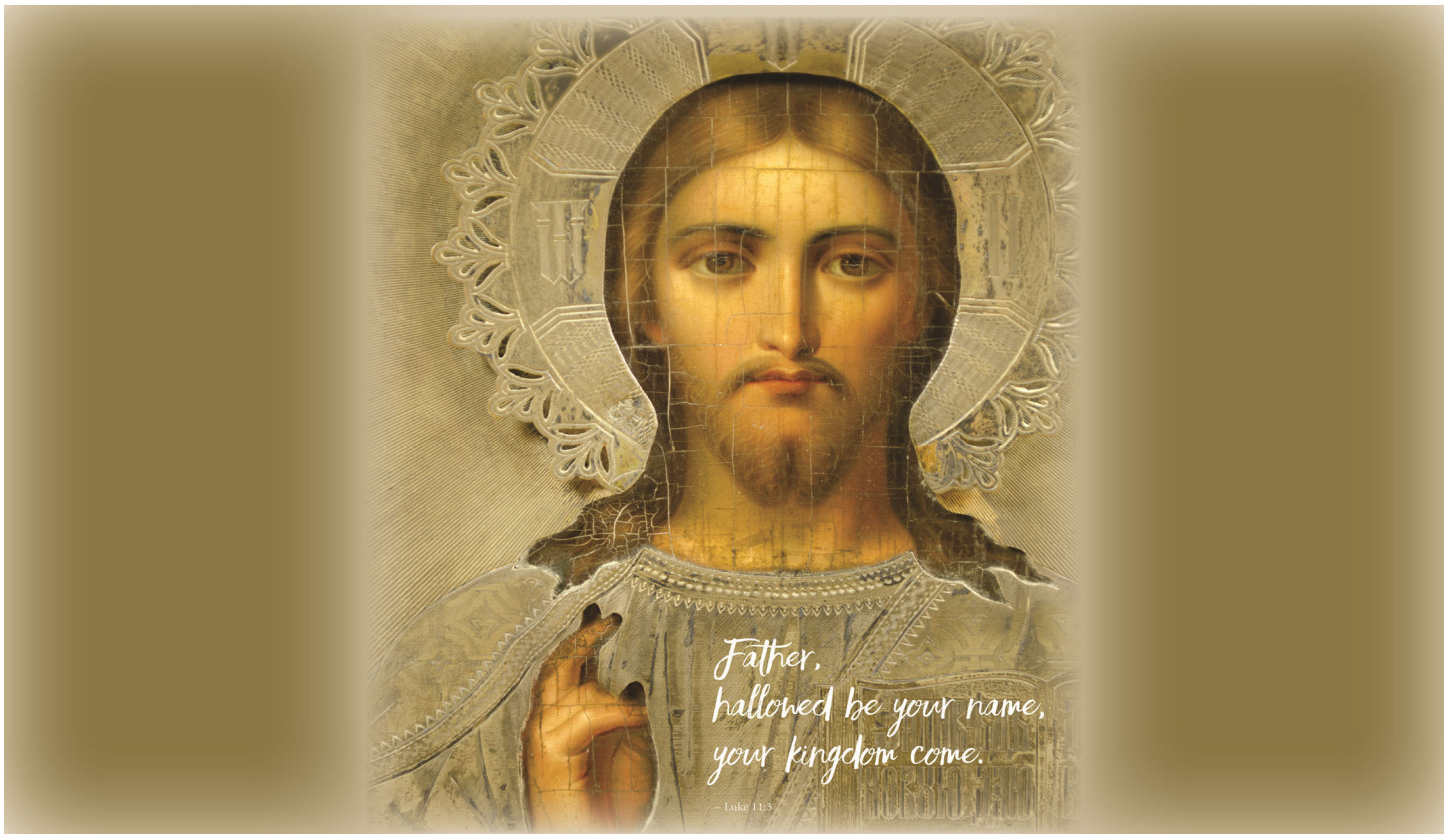

NEWS FOR LAKE GENEVA KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COUNCIL 1647

Did you know?

This past year the Knights of Columbus at our parish have accomplished a lot for our community and most people are not aware of what they do. Below are the 4 main program areas that the Knights focused on this past year and they were one of the very few in the state to receive the prestigious award of Star Council. The four areas of focus are Faith, Family, Community and Life.

1. Faith Programs completed in 2018-2019.
 - A. RSVP – Our council raised funds from our monthly breakfast to support Seminarians such as Dominic Lazeroni. and in the past John Baumgartner.
 - B. Spiritual Reflection – 25 Knights participated in the Advent Day of Reflection on Dec 15th. 5 Knights led the rosary portion of the event.
 - C. Rosary Program – Knights invited parishioners to pray the Rosary in addition to 30 minutes prior to morning mass each day.
2. Family Programs
 - A. Food for Families – We held a KC breakfast where we raised \$500.00 with 118 man hours of labor which was donated to the local food pantry. We also had two members who raised 1250 lbs of food and donated it to the food pantry. A special thank you goes out to Bill Meyerhofer as well as Richard Kelman.
 - B. Family of the Month and Year – Our parish nominated worthy family's and a KC committee selected a monthly family and presented them with a certificate and listing in the bulletin. Family of the year will be presented at the Steak fry which is given to a Knight family that served the church and the Knights during the year.
 - C. Keep Christ in Christmas – We purchased “Keep Christ in Christmas” signs and sold them at our breakfast fundraiser.
 - D. Consecration to the Holy Family – Dec 30th we worked with Fr Mark and Michael Dean to have a holy family homily and we handed out prayer cards prior to each mass.
3. Community Programs
 - A. Coats for Kids – We purchased 72 youth sized coats and distributed them to our parish school and local public grade schools.
 - B. Free Throw Championship – Working with our Parish principal, we had a free through contest with 88 students that participated.
 - C. Helping Hands – We cleaned and updated our church rectory; we cleaned one mile of highway 50 from the Kenosha county line back toward Lake Geneva. We also raised and donated \$10,000 towards the rectory for repairs.
4. Life Programs –
 - A. March for Life. Tim Grossi and his family joined a March for life in Chicago on January 13th.
 - B. Novena for Life – Our church participated in Novena for life with 9 days of prayer and spiritual reflection January 14-22nd.
 - C. Pregnancy Center Support – Each year our council donates money we raised from our breakfast fundraiser to pay for a table at the Pregnancy help center fund raiser as well as some of the knights donating their time at the center.
 - D. Christian Refugee Relief – Our council held a breakfast fundraiser and donated the money to Christian Refugee Relief.
 - E. Special Olympics - Our council donated money to the law enforcement torch run for special Olympics.
5. In addition to the programs listed above, the knights have the following fund raisers:
 - A. Monthly breakfast on the second Sunday of each month at the church as a fund raiser.
 - B. The Knights volunteer at the Brat House during the county fair
 - C. The Knights volunteer for a day at the Piggly Wiggly Food trailer
 - D. Glads for Dads where we raised over \$1,000 and donated the money back to the church for repairs.
 - E. Our largest fundraiser is the Tootsie Roll Drive where we raise funds for children with intellectual disabilities. This past year we raised over \$5,000.
 - F. Life Savers for Life.

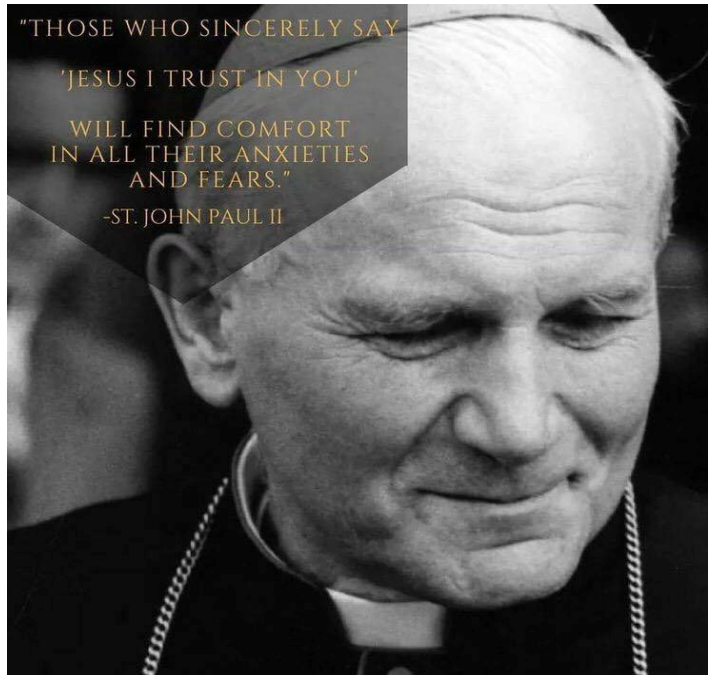

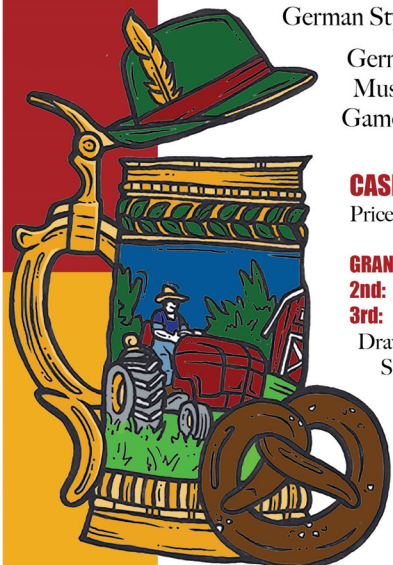
