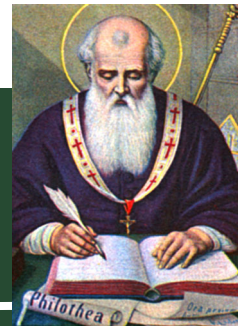

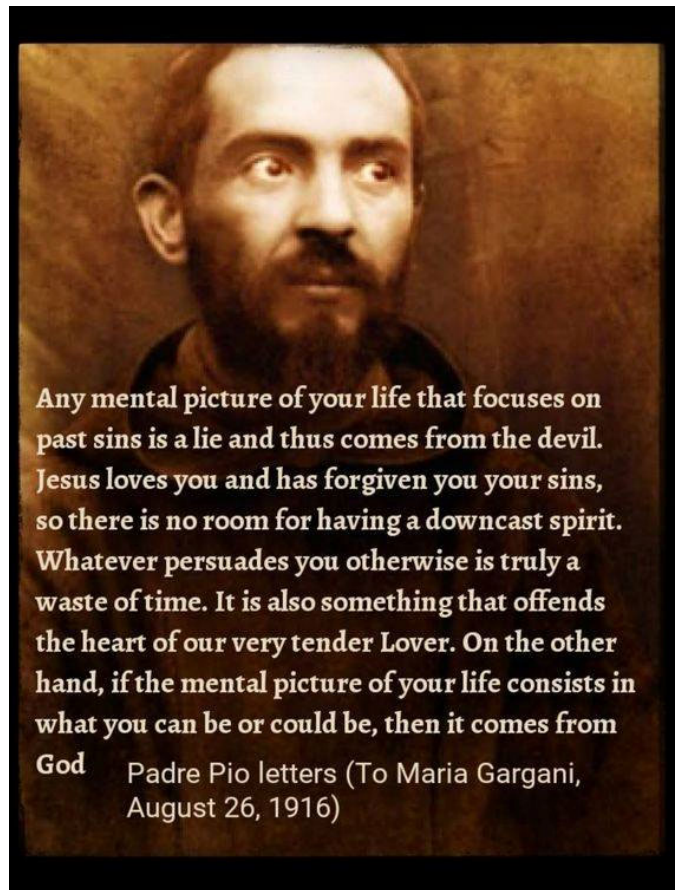
### Mick “Coach” Keyes
