## OCTOBER IS RIGHT TO LIFE MONTH

Surveys show that more than two-thirds of Americans are deeply uncomfortable with the legacy of Roe vs. Wade. By a margin of more than three to one, people believe that abortion should be legal in only a few circumstances. There is a pro-life moral consensus in the America. The Knights of Columbus' constant message is on the importance and dignity of all human life. Your Knights are collecting donations after all Masses on Oct. 5 & 6 to provide pregnancy centers across Wisconsin and Illinois with state-of-the-art ultrasound machines, which cost around \$25,000. With these machines, pregnant women considering an abortion can see a real life picture of their baby developing within them. The \$6 million collected by the Knights in the last three years has resulted in the purchase of 250 ultrasound machines in 45 states.
