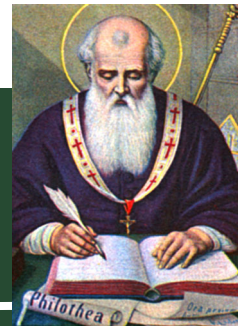

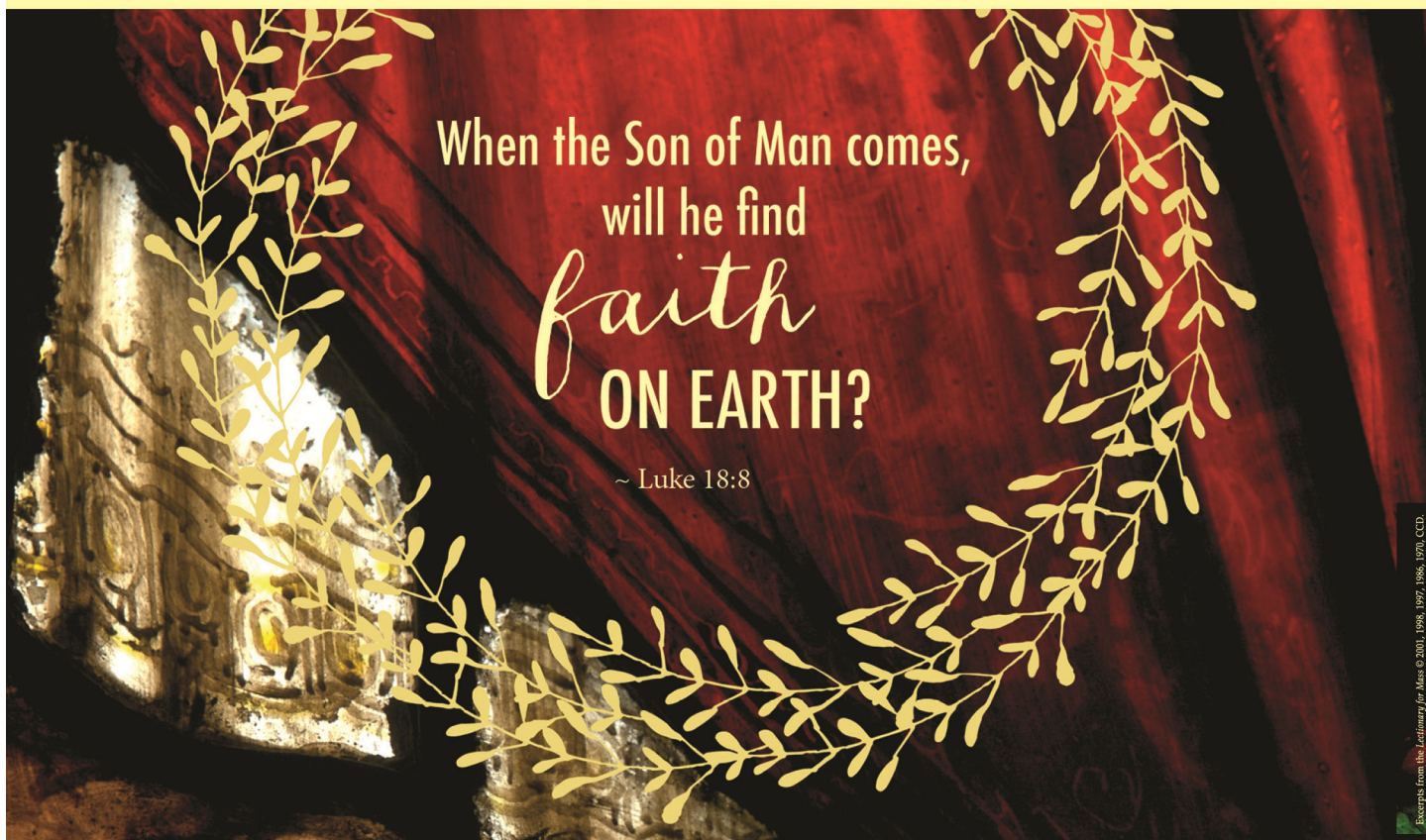

Inspire us to protect the threatened life of the unborn.

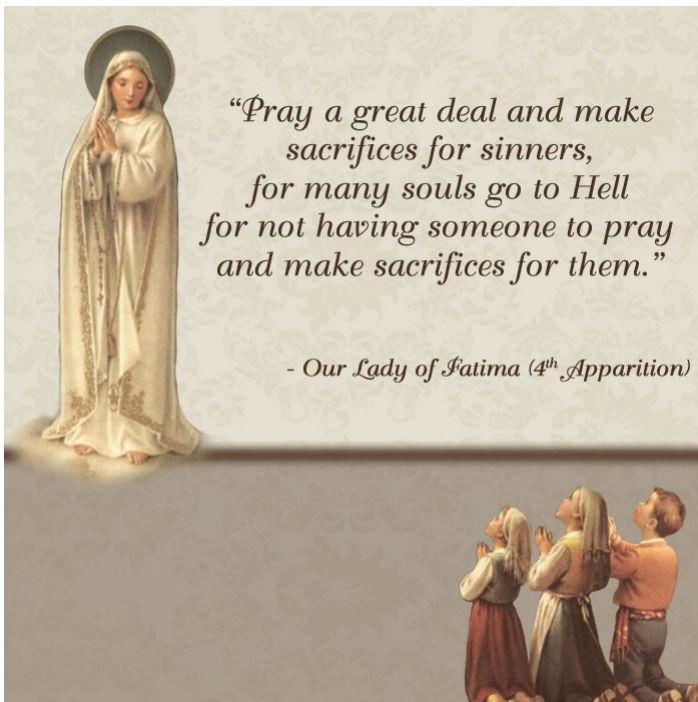
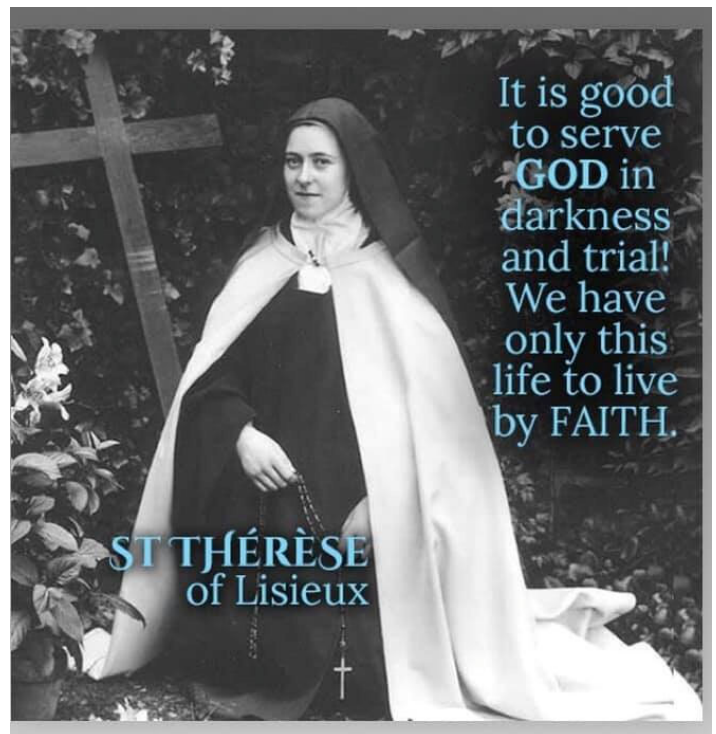
Strengthen us to bring comfort to the infirm.

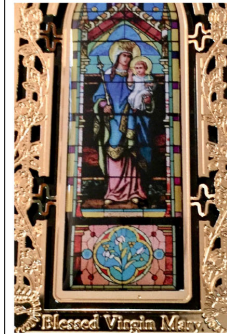

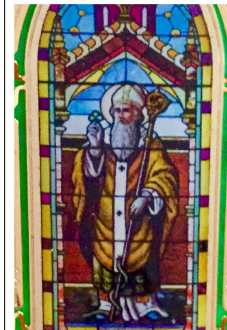
