COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Religious Education: This started September 8th for elementary school students. High school will start September 29th. The mission trips were all successful. Plans for next year have been started.

Finance Committee: The committee meeting was postponed.

Human Concerns: There was no meeting last month. Terry Maus said she is planning to do something with the students for the victims of the hurricane. Kathy made a motion to have a second collection for the victims. Dave seconded the motion.
