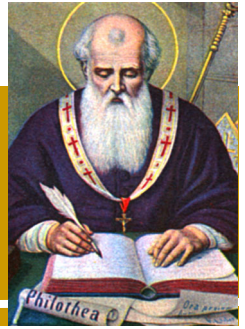

**KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS NEWS**

The Wisconsin State Council of the Knights of Columbus is currently selling raffle tickets for its 2020 Charity Raffle. The prize list consists of \$124,000 being paid to one hundred winners with a first prize of \$50,000 or a 2020 Ford F150. The second prize is \$25,000 or a 2020 Harley motorcycle. The third prize through one hundredth prize are \$500 each. The drawing will take place at the State Convention on Saturday May 2, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at the KI Convention Center in Green Bay. Tickets are \$5.00 and we will be selling them at our Breakfast this Sunday.

The proceeds from this raffle are used to ease financial burdens and restore hope to families and victims of accidents and illness. This past year, the Knights made charitable donations from their local Councils charity fund to needy persons in their communities in an amount in excess of \$323,000. In addition, the State Council issued grants to needy families throughout Wisconsin in an amount in excess of \$174,000. That totaled nearly \$500,000.

## BOOK STUDIES

For the past 5 ½ years SFDS has offered Monday night and Thursday morning book studies. During that time we have read and discussed books by many authors including Fr. Michael Gaitley, Matthew Kelly, Sherry Weddell and others. The topics have varied but all have been by Catholic authors and last Lent instead of reading a book on a particular subject we read THE BOOK (Bible) using a format called Lectio Divina. We used the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) book "Lectio Divina of the Gospels" and each week of Lent we read the Gospel for the upcoming Sunday and then followed the format of reading it several times, praying about it and contemplating specific questions related to the Gospel. At class we would discuss our answers to the questions and share our insights.

For Advent this year we only had a class on Monday nights and used a wonderful program from Ascension Press by Fr. Mark Toups entitled "Rejoice! Advent Meditations with Joseph". Although it is generally the busiest time of the year for most of us, those who were able to join the Monday night group and do the short daily readings and watch the videos each week at class all agreed that, not only was this one of their best Advents ever but the insight they gained into the Person of St. Joseph were most amazing and faith-building.

All book studies will be announced several weeks in advance in our Bulletin and in the media center and on our website so stay tuned for our next study and please join us. The cost of the book is the only cost for the class and scholarships are available if someone is unable to cover the cost. Looking forward to meeting new people in the coming classes and continuing friendships of those who have been involved before!

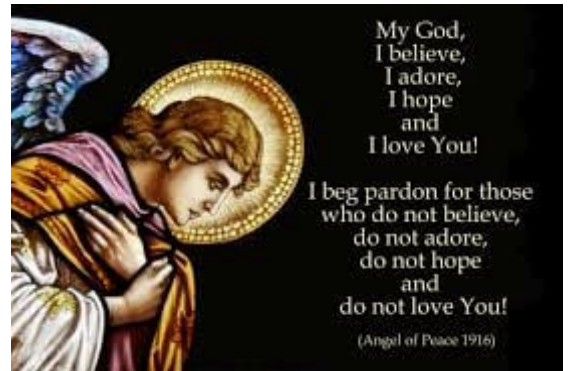
