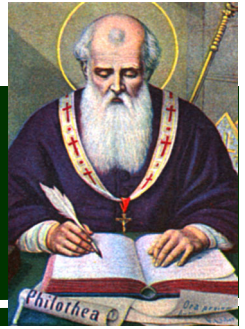

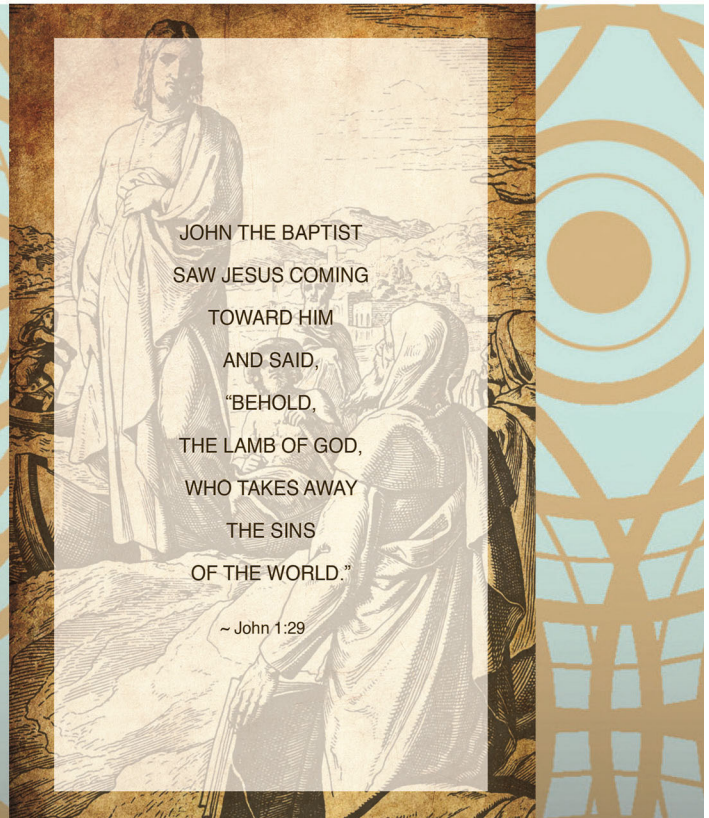

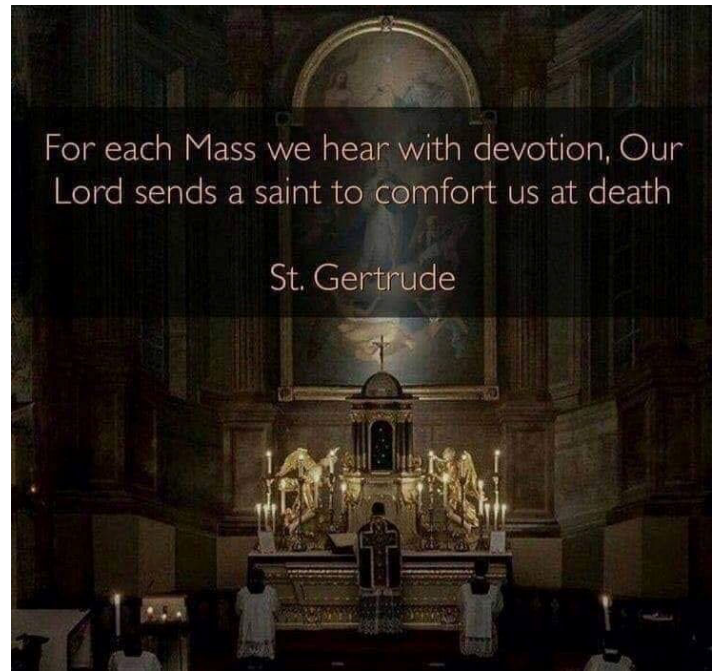

We are seeking a Construction Manager

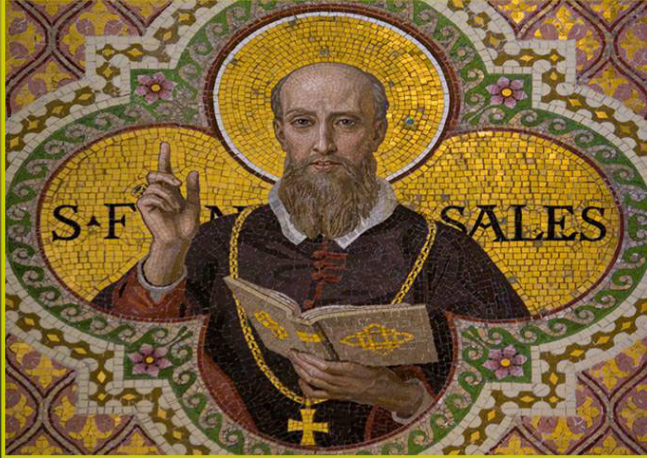
Responsibilities include:
