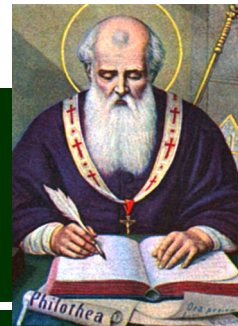

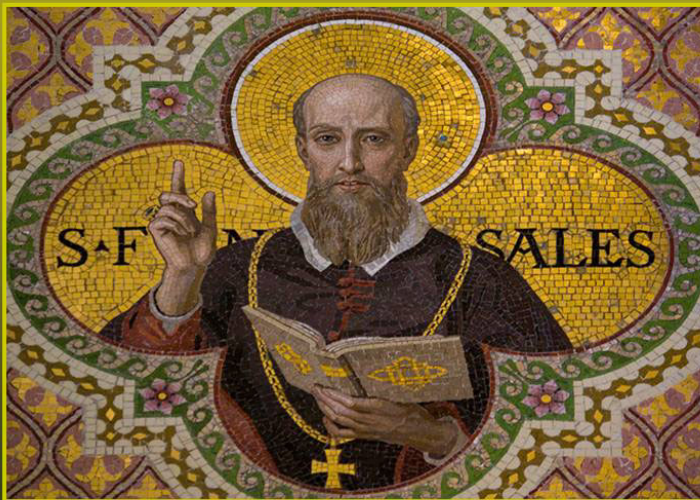

THURSDAY MORNINGS will run from THIS THURSDAY, Jan. 30 through THURSDAY, Feb. 20 and will meet from 10-11:30 a.m.. We will be using "The Lectio Divina of the Gospels" by the USCCB. It can be purchased on Amazon for about \$16 but we will provide study sheets for those who don't have a book.
