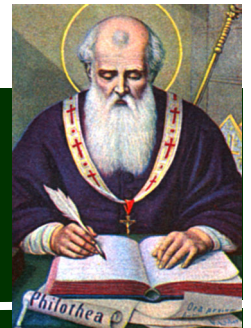

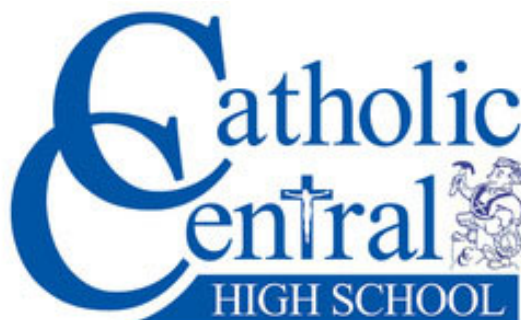

It can be purchased on Amazon for about \$16 but we will provide study sheets for those who don't have a book.
