The Archdiocese of Milwaukee wants parishioners to be cautious of online scammers. Several people reported strange emails and texts that appeared to come from their pastor. They state the pastor needs their help and then asks for iTunes gift cards. Some of the emails/texts were personalized with people's names. The Archdiocese says if you get a message you believe to be suspicious, call the parish office or call police.
