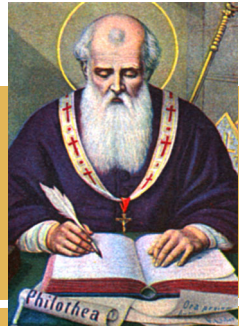

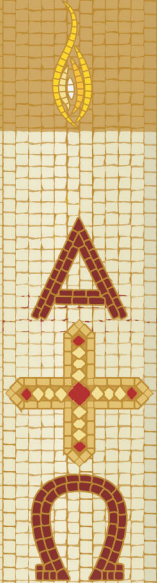

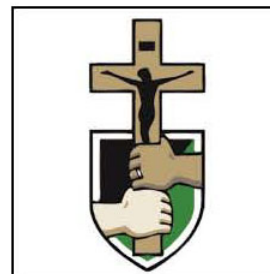

OUR CHRISTIAN ATTITUDE IN THE MIDST OF THE CORONAVIRUS

As we face this worldwide challenge together, I want to communicate to the Community of St. Francis de Sales some words of encouragement and also to let you know that you are not alone!

Today the whole world is in the midst of difficult times, tough times. For many people, the first reaction is to complain: *I can't do this; it is just too much; it is too hard. I am living in a cage. When is this going to end!*

Be careful with this type of thinking; the devil wants to discourage you, and he wants you to complain against God: Why, Lord, why is this happening to us?

Just keep on praying. Keep on trusting in the Lord. Feel always that God is on our side, and He will never let us down.

God has wonderful promises for us in the Holy Scripture. One of His promises to His people is that He will always be with us and that He will never abandon us. He said in the letter to the Hebrews: **"I will never forsake you or abandon you. The Lord is my helper, and I will not be afraid."**

While celebrating the Mass last week, suddenly the words of the Lord resounded in me more than ever. Remember that before giving each other the sign of peace in the Mass, the priest says: **"Lord Jesus Christ, who said to you apostles: Peace I leave you; my peace I give you."** (John 14:27) And the Lord tells us: **"Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."**

In the midst of my worries and anxieties these words: **"Peace I leave you; my peace I give you,"** calmed me down and gave a new meaning to the challenging times we are experiencing.

This promise of the Lord kept on coming to my mind so often during the day, that before going to sleep, I just said: Thank you, Jesus, for your peace; and give peace especially to all those who follow you, to all your disciples, to all parishioners, etc.

So my call to you is to trust in the Lord, and He will give us direction, and we will get through this, and this storm will come to pass, and it will end.

And I believe, my brothers and sisters, this is going to end well. God, as always, is in control of everything, and He is teaching us some important lessons for our life, and He is giving to many other people another chance to come back to Him.

Remember that God promised us: **"Be strong and steadfast; have no fear... I will march with you... I will never fail you or forsake you."** (Cf. Deut. 31:6).

I am not saying that God is going to deliver us from any problem, disruptions or annoyances, because all of us are going to experience some inconveniences.

It is time to reflect on the many blessings the Lord has given us. Let's not even complain about the inconveniences, but thank God for what we already have, His blessings in our lives, etc.

This is a great time for praying, thinking of other people and trying to help them without risking our own health. There are so many people around with greater needs than our own needs.

We want you to know that we love you and we are praying for you every day.

We are all in this together and with the MERCY OF GOD we are all going to come out of this trial together.

My brothers and sisters, remember that no winter lasts forever. Difficult times don't last forever. This too shall pass.

and for those who have died.

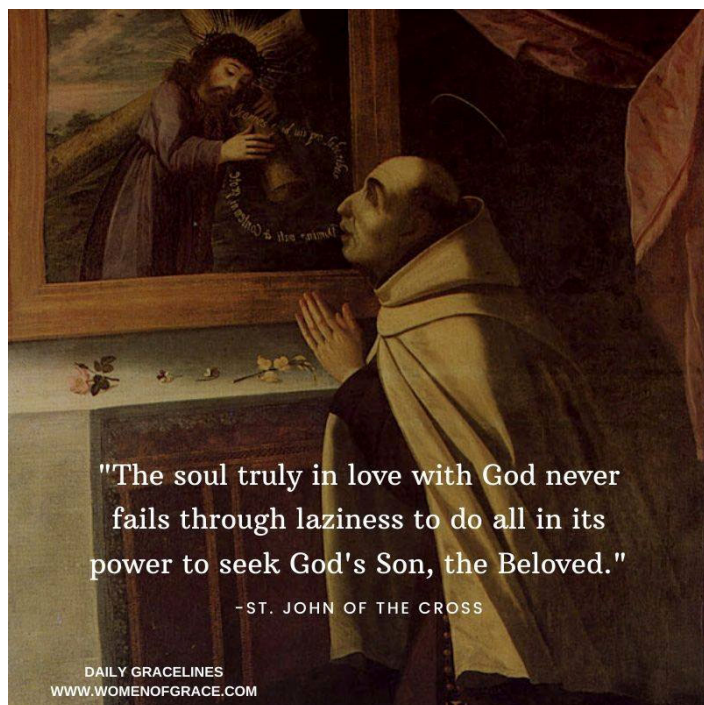
Intercede also for those charged with
