The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has recently announced that Fr. Ray Guthrie will become the new parish administrator of St. Francis de Sales Parish on August 4, 2020. More details will be coming soon!



PUBLIC MASS RESUMES

I am very excited to announce that we will begin the public celebration of the Mass again on the weekend of May 30-31, 2020. This is such a great time to be able to return to Mass as it is the Feast of Pentecost. On this day we celebrate the Holy Spirit coming down upon the apostles and giving them the grace and strength to spread the truth of Christ throughout the world. I pray that that same Holy Spirit guides us through this time and renews our parish, country and world. I wanted to highlight some points to note to ensure your safety as you return to worship with us:

- Weekend Masses will be on Saturday at 4:00 and 5:30 p.m. and Sunday at 7:30, 9:00 and 10:30 a.m. The 5:30 p.m. Mass on Saturday will be in Spanish.
- Confessions will be on Saturday at 3:00 p.m.
- We are required to limit our capacity to 25%. We will utilize both the sanctuary and the parish center (if needed). Our capacity for each Mass will be around 170 people.
- To help us monitor our numbers we will be utilizing an online sign-up form. A link to this form will be sent the week before Mass starts. You can also call the parish office at 262-248-8524 to sign-up.
- We will allow at least 40 spaces at each Mass to account for walk ins.
- There is nothing that you need to bring with you to let us know you signed up for that Mass. The online form is to help us have a better idea of our numbers.
- You can easily go in and adjust your Mass time if needed. Again, please remember that this is not a reservation system. It is a way for us to gauge our numbers at each Mass. We don't want to turn anyone away.
- Please enter the church from the rear parking lot entrance or the outside entrance coming into the side chapel. The main door on Route 50 and the breezeway doors will be locked and can only be used for exiting.
- Please use the provided hand sanitizer when entering and exiting the building.
- At the end of Mass, please wait for an usher to come to your row to dismiss you. You will then be able to exit out the door closest to your vehicle.
- During Mass, please use your discretion and maintain the proper distance between those who are not members of your family. Every other pew will be roped off so that we can maintain proper distance.
- The use of masks at Mass is encouraged but is not a requirement.
- Communion will be distributed in the hands only (this is per archdiocesan directive).
- Restrooms will be open and the church and the restrooms will be cleaned after each Mass. Some final important considerations:
- We are so happy to welcome you back to Mass but please remember that if you are hesitant to do so yet it is okay to stay home.
- The dispensation for the obligation to attend Mass extends through July 5, 2020 and will be reevaluated at that point.
- If you are not feeling well, please remain at home.
- We will still be offering a recorded Mass on our YouTube channel each Sunday morning.
- Our weekday hours during this time are Tuesday: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (adoration then Night Prayer at 6:00 p.m.) and Wednesday and Thursday 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Note that the parish office is still closed to in person business. Please call or email the parish office during business hours if you need anything.

We ask you to be patient with us as we adjust to these norms and we are looking forward to seeing you soon. May the peace of the risen Christ reign in our hearts now and always!

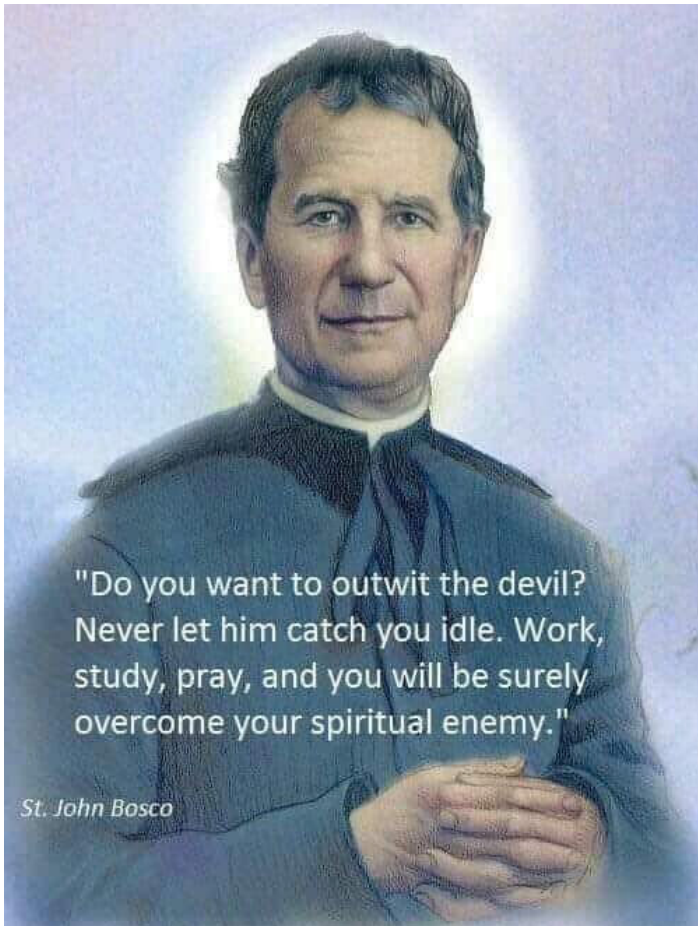

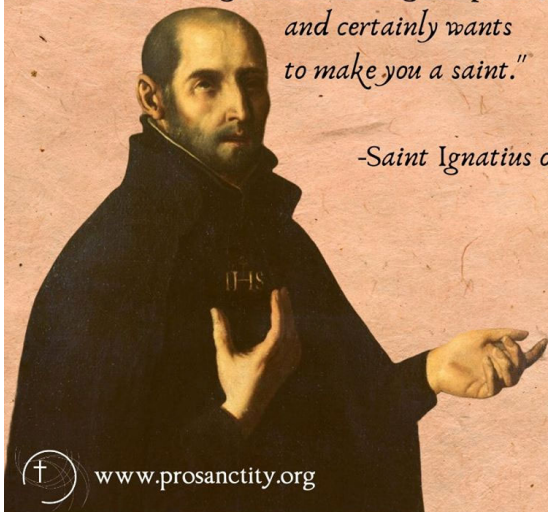

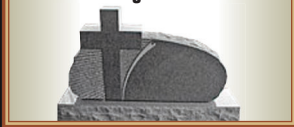
