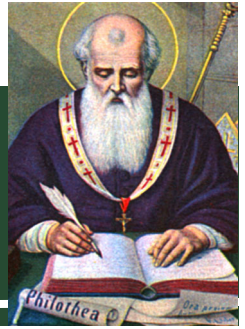

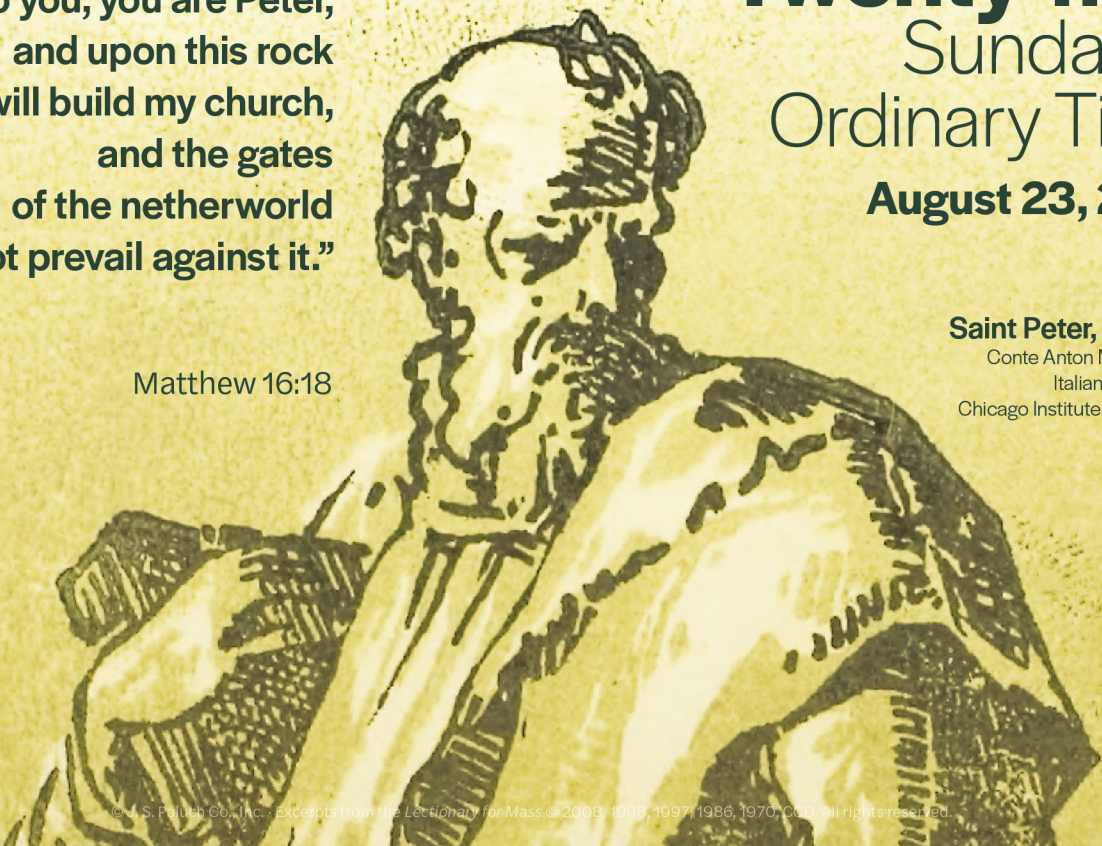

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS PRESS RELEASE

Lake Geneva WI – Knights of Columbus (Lake Geneva) Council (1647) in (Lake Geneva) was awarded the distinction of Star Council, the international organization’s top honor for local councils.

The Star Council Award recognizes overall excellence in the areas of growing membership, promoting Knights of Columbus insurance benefits, sponsoring Catholic faith formation programs and volunteering time through service-oriented activities.



2019-2020 Council Programs Completed for Star Council Award:

1. Faith Programs
 - a. RSVP – Support for Seminarians ie Dominic Lazzaroni., paid \$500 from breakfast fundraiser.
 - b. Spiritual Reflection –Advent Day of Reflection. January 2020 Knights each saying a decade of the rosary and then watching the movie Unplanned in the Parish Center.
 - c. Rosary Program – Knights and parishioners to pray the Rosary quarterly with the parish.
2. Family Programs
 - a. Food for Families –\$500.00 donation and 1000 lbs of food 10/30/2019, October Breakfast fund raiser to donate \$500. Knights raised food in their gardens and donated the food to the local food pantry.
 - b. Family of the Month and Year – Parish families are regonized for their contributions to the parish and the community monthly and then one family is selected for family of the year.
 - c. Keep Christ in Christmas. Our council sells yard signs and car magnets at November and December breakfast to Keep Christ in Christmas.
 - d. Consecration to the Holy Family – Sunday after Christmas prayer cards are handed out at each English and Spanish mass. Our priest centers his homily around the family and says the prayer with the entire church.
3. Community Programs
 - a. Coats/gym shoes for Kids – September through December. The Knights were able to give away all of the coats for kids with Tree House Child and Family Center taking all of the remaining coats after SFDS and Central-Denison.
 - b. Free Throw Championship – Every year our council works with our parish school children to have a competition and the winners advance to the district.
 - c. Helping Hands –Our council picks up trash for one mile along highway 50 in the spring and fall each year from the Kenosha County line back toward Lake Geneva.
 - d. Essay Contest 12/30/2019, each year the Knights works with the Parish school based on a selected topic to receive essays from the students. Judges grade the essays and submit them to Supreme. This includes giving a \$50 gift card to the wining entrant and the teacher that helped with this event.
4. Life Programs
 - a. March for Life – Each year members from our council attend the March for life in Chicago.
 - b. Novena for Life –9 days of prayer and spiritual reflection in January.
 - c. New Days Women’s Clinic – Our council supported the Walworth County pregnancy hotline which has been renamed this year to New Day Women’s Clinic. Our council along with the Elkhorn raised money for a much needed ultra sound machine. This service works with women to show them an ultrasound of their unborn child and provides counseling to pregnant women that would otherwise seek an abortion.
 - d. Christian Refugee Relief –each year our council donates to Christian Refugee Relief.
 - e. Special Olympics - law enforcement torch run for special Olympics in June
5. In addition to the programs listed above, the knights have the following fund raisers:
 - a. Monthly breakfast on the second Sunday of each month at the church as a fund raiser. This is temporarily not being done due to Covid.
 - b. The Knights volunteer at the Wurst House during the county fair.
 - c. Our largest fund raiser is the Tootsie Roll Drive where we raise funds for children with intellectual disabilities. May.
 - d. Glad’s for Dads -Father’s Day June
 - e. The Knights volunteer for a day at the Piggly Wiggly Food trailer June
 - f. Life Savers for Life October.


Again this is for ALL of our parishioners not just our elderly and shut-ins. This will begin soon! We will have a contact person to call if you would like to receive communion.
