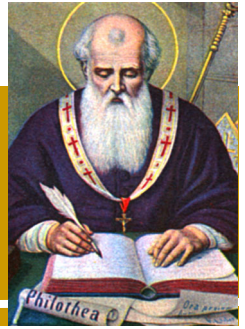

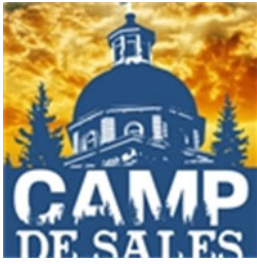

Today is Mother's Day in the United States. This means that many of us will get together with our mothers to celebrate their lives and thank them for their faithfulness. In addition to thanking our mothers, taking them out for a meal, and giving them a card, many of us will also go to church with them. Mother's Day has higher church attendance than just about any other Sunday of the year which is not Easter or Christmas.

Many churches make a big deal of Mother's Day. But some churches ignore it because "it's not a Catholic feast." Indeed, it doesn't show up in the liturgical calendar, which is still focusing on the celebration of Easter. But, beyond this fact, some churches seemed to assume that paying attention to mothers wasn't really spiritual enough. Have we forgotten the most venerated title that St. Mary holds is "Mother of God?" Many icons of Our Blessed Mother always put the Greek Letters for Mother of God in the two upper corners.

So as we honor our Mothers on this weekend, Living and Dead, please recall that even God honored his Mother by assuring that her Body would not be tarnished by Sin or Death as she was born Immaculate and Assumed into Heaven. 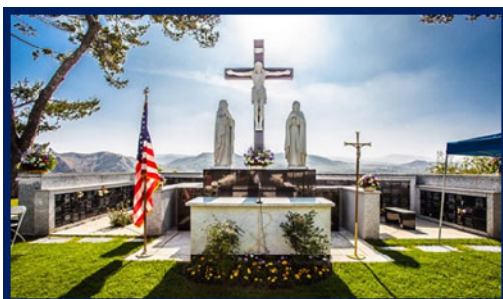
MEMORIAL DAY MASS ON MONDAY, MAY 31ST

“A ustedes los llamo amigos”

VI Domingo de Pascua, año B - Juan 15, 9-17



A la comunidad hispana de Lake Geneva:

¡Paz y Bien!

Les ofrezco una pequeña meditación del Evangelio de este Domingo.

En este pasaje del Evangelio de Juan (continuación directa del pasaje del Domingo pasado) el término **amor** aparece ¡nueve veces! Junto a este término encontramos otro igualmente importante que Jesús aplica a sus discípulos: los llama **amigos** (Jn 15,15).

¿Qué significa el amor para Jesús, qué significa ser sus amigos?

En primer lugar, amar para Jesús significa que el otro sea parte de tu vida, tanto así que ya no lo puedas abandonar. Además, este cuidado es recíproco. Es precisamente esta la relación que hay entre el Jesús y su Padre, son una sola cosa. De la misma manera Jesús nos ha amado, es por eso que pide a sus discípulos que *permanezcan* en este amor.

Para nosotros, la experiencia de permanecer ha sido a veces algo problemática. En nuestra fragilidad humana no pocas veces hemos experimentado el abandono, la soledad, que los otros huyan cuando más los necesitamos etc. Dios conoce bien nuestra vida. Si seguimos leyendo los siguientes capítulos veremos incluso que casi ninguno de los discípulos *permanecerá* con Jesús cuando lo arrestan, cada uno se perderá.

Para Jesús, amar significa ofrecer al otro un hogar tan seguro, tan abierto y acogedor, de tal manera que tu puedas volver y sentirte como en casa, como si nunca te hubieras ido.

El saber *permanecer* no pertenece al ámbito de nuestras capacidades humanas, pero en el horizonte de la misericordia de Dios, él nos ha llamado **amigos**, al grado ofrecernos un refugio seguro para *permanecer* incluso en cuando pecamos o huimos: no importa cuán lejos puedas haber llegado, nunca dejarás de estar fuera de este abrazo, de este hogar.

Dios quiere esta nueva experiencia de vida entre sus discípulos. Donde todos, día a día aprendan a amarse, a ser el uno para el otro un buen refugio.

Dios nos puede dar la gracia de vivir esta vocación de cristianos. Podremos ser testimonios de que, entre nosotros, hay una relación más fuerte que la de los lazos de sangre, una relación que demuestre que el otro me interesa y no puedo dejar de cuidarlo.

Esto significa ser amigos al estilo del Señor.
