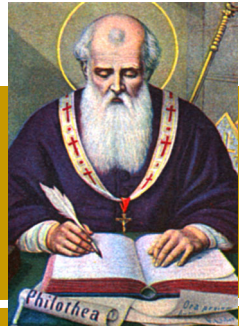


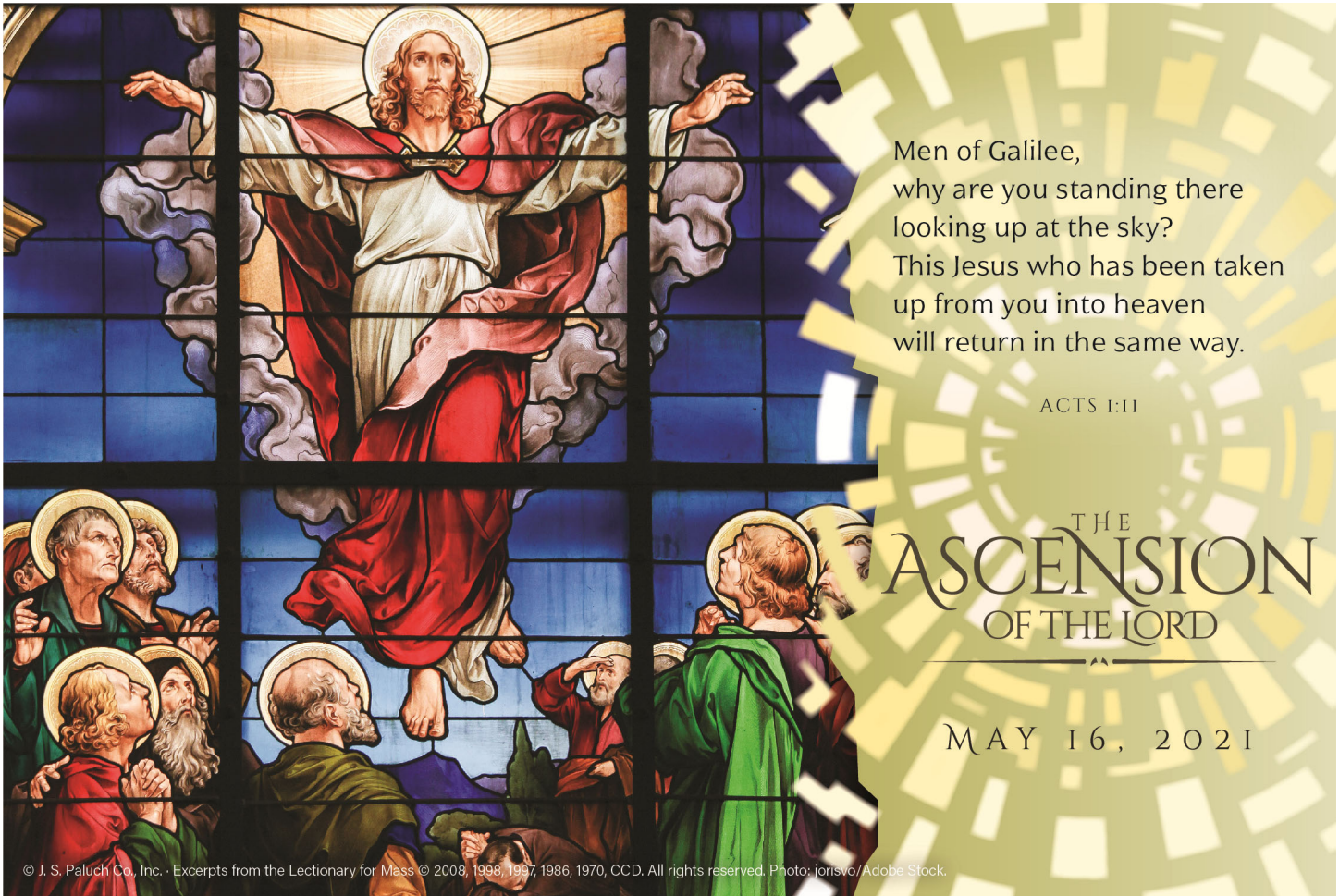

### MAY CROWNING

Just a reminder that our grade school children will be having a May Crowning of Our Blessed Virgin Mary on May 19<sup>th</sup>. Keep them in your prayers as we celebrate the gift of Our Blessed Virgin Mary during this special month dedicated to her great Love for her Son Jesus Christ the King of all Creation.



Following the biblical tradition in Jewish practices of the Kingdom of Israel, the Mother of the King was always considered the Queen of the Kingdom, not the wife of the King. Hence we crown Our Blessed Mother: Mary as the Mother of God: Jesus Christ as the Queen of all Creation. Hail Holy Queen, Mother of the Church and Mother of Humanity.

As St. Paul stated often in His Letters, that Jesus is the New Adam, hence Mary is the New Eve. The New Eve who does not follow the ways of the Serpent, but crushes the head of the Serpent. ### FEAST OF ST. ISIDORE



St. Isidore was born in 1070 to a peasant family near Madrid, Spain. He was baptized “Isidore” in honor of the famous archbishop of Seville. Isidore the farmer was actually a day laborer, working on the farm of the wealthy John de Vergas at Torrelaguna, just outside Madrid. He married a poor girl, Maria Torribia. Their only child, a son, died in infancy.

The couple took a vow of continence to serve God. Isidore’s life is a model of simple Christian charity and faith. He prayed while at work. He shared what he had with the poor, even his meals. He often gave them more than he had for himself.

A story told about St. Isidore (feast day, May 15) is that he often came later to work in the fields than other laborers because he would first attend Mass in the morning. Yet his work never suffered and he always met the chores required of him. It was said two angels, one on either side of Isidore, appeared and joined their pious companion in plowing the fields. In representations, St. Isidore is portrayed as a peasant with a sickle or staff, and sometimes with an angel or white oxen near him. He died in 1130 and was canonized in 1622. T

he virtues found in the life of Isidore – commitment to family, love for the land, service to the poor and a deep spirituality – are qualities that still can be found in rural America. “We thank God for our rural lives, formed still by the rhythms of nature and church. With you, help us to rejoice in the relationships with God and each other. St. Isidore, pray for us.”

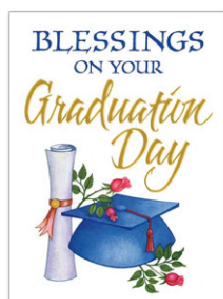

## BOLETÍN INFORMATIVO COMUNIDAD HISPANA

*Contigo estará siempre la fuerza de Dios*

Domingo de la Ascensión, Marcos 16, 15-20, ciclo B

A la comunidad hispana de Lake Geneva:



En esta solemnidad de la Ascensión de Jesús, normalmente entendemos que subiendo a los cielos se separa por completo de nosotros, pero no es así, no se fue para siempre. En el Credo recitamos y creemos que el Señor subió a los cielos, pero según lo que leemos hoy parece que se quedó en lo más profundo de nosotros, pues dice el Evangelio: *"actuaba junto a ellos y confirmaba la Palabra con los signos que la acompañaban"* (Marcos 16, 20).

Jesús vuelve a llamar a un grupo de hombres asustados y confundidos, a un núcleo de mujeres valientes y fieles, y les confía el mundo de todos los días, con los problemas y sufrimientos que ya conocemos: *Y salieron y predicaron por todas partes ...* Y lo hace porque cree en ellos, a pesar de haber entendido poco, a pesar de haber traicionado y negado, y muchos todavía dudaban (Marcos 16, 11).

Y cuánta alegría debemos sentir al saber que Dios confía en nosotros, en nuestras manos, en nuestro corazón. Dios confía en tí más que tu mismo; Él sabe que eres capaz de contagiar a los que te rodean con su mensaje de alegría y de paz.

*"El Señor actuaba con ellos"*, junto a ellos, con sus mismas obras. Es esta la última presentación de Jesús según el Evangelio de Marcos: **Él es fuerza que trabaja contigo de por vida, tu fuerza y la del Señor son una sola y solo hay buenos resultados.**

De ahora en adelante Él está contigo en cada gesto de bondad, cuando ofreces una palabra buena y viva, cuando construyes la paz, cuando das una mano al que lo necesita. En tus manos, sus manos; Existir es saber que Dios vive y trabaja en toda tu vida.

Es hermoso saber que cuando Jesús ha entrado al cielo, se llevó nuestra humanidad y ahí donde llegó El Pastor, llegará también su rebaño, cada uno de nosotros.
