

ST. FRANCIS DE SALES PARISH
Pastoral Council Meeting
May 8, 2018

MEMBERS PRESENT: Daryl Braun, Millie McCormick, Sandra Cruz, Kurt Kayser, AnneMarie Janikowski, Kathy Murray, Gene Bulla, Ricardo Lagunas and Lois Maywald. Also attending was Will Murray. Millie called the meeting to order at 6:05, followed by reading the opening prayer.

A motion was made to approve the agenda by Kathy and seconded by AnneMarie. The agenda was approved. A motion was then made by Kurt to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2018 meeting. It was seconded by Gene and the minutes were approved.

Sandra Cruz introduced the youth representatives: Abraham Fonseca and Isabella Peetz, who told a little about themselves.

OLD BUSINESS:

Millie asked the liaisons if they have been talking about the goals with their committees. Kathy said she added the positions next to the members' names on the back page of the bulletin. She also set up permanent ads for both St. Francis and Catholic Central schools.

Millie also mentioned that we need a schedule showing all activities at St. Benedict's and at St. Francis.

Lois said she talked to Ellyn von Rabenau, who does the Website, and the minutes will be put on it again.

NEW BUSINESS:

Fall Festival: Kurt said the festival is four months away. They will have a planning meeting next Tuesday. He said he did get the information on the 2017 festival from Kathy.

DAS Update: They had two candidates. They made an offer to one, but it was turned down. The other one already took a job and withdrew her application. A CPA named Kris has been hired for one day a week. She will be a Financial Assistant. She already does several other churches including St. Benedict's. There was discussion on whether we would have enough money in the budget to hire a full time DAS. It was mentioned that hiring the part time person would be a good idea. There was concern that it does not help Father Mark with his workload.

Rectory Committee: This committee will have a meeting tomorrow. Father Mark requested that we put together a list of what we want for the rectory for one year, five years, and ten years.

Financial Update: Daryl said the Generous Hearts campaign has had a 5.6% of respondents. The Angel Fund was again discussed. They have enough money for about two years. School Choice may help the Angel Fund with fewer families needing help. Kurt said Eric Gallagher would like to have a collection for Angel Fund done through the school year. A suggestion was made to invite Eric to our next meeting to discuss the Angel Fund. Millie will invite him for the June meeting.

August Joint Social: Millie and Barb Makovec are thinking of having a joint light supper for all staff members from both churches in August. They would have a short presentation from the Archdiocese.

Resignation of Mary Ferrini: Mary has resigned. She was an at-large member. We will not fill that position.

Review of Eucharistic Ministers Procedures: Gene said we need to review the Eucharistic Ministers procedures for 5:15 mass. There has been a change from 7 to 5 ministers. He mentioned that, in the summer months, there is an increase in attendance. Gene will bring this up to the Prayer and Worship Committee.

CDA Gift to St. Francis: Lois mentioned that the Catholic Daughters are thinking of purchasing a television to be mounted on the wall in the Parish Center. It could be used for meetings in the Center and possibly have the program at the Welcome Center running there also.

School Addition: Daryl said there will be another Road Runner event. They are thinking of building out the corner of the school for the main entrance and office. They are working on a government grant application for school safety.

Motion was made by AnneMarie to adjourn. Sandra seconded it and the meeting was adjourned at 7:15.
