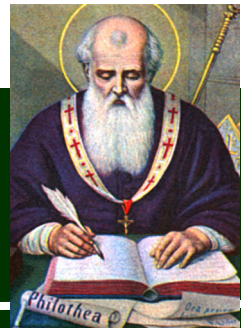

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

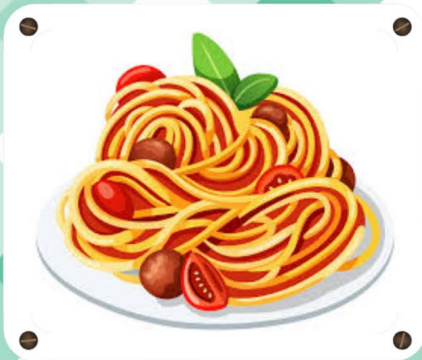

INQUIRY FOR DISCERNMENT PROGRAM

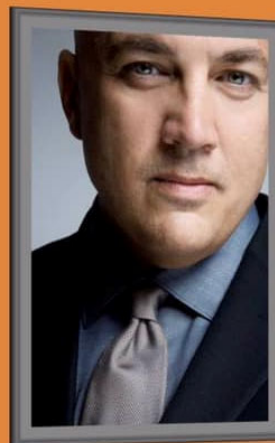
