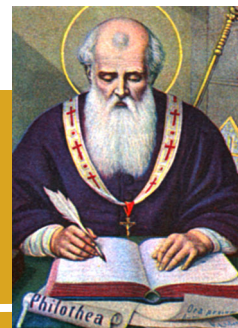

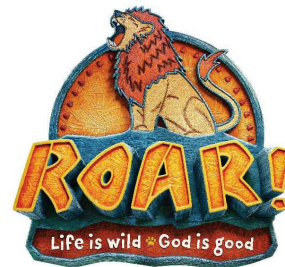
MASS FOR THE HOMEBOUND

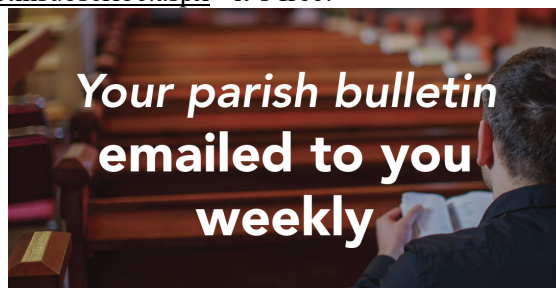
SWING FOR YOUR SEMINARIANS!
