the best way you can and offer them to God. That way they are converted into prayer as well.

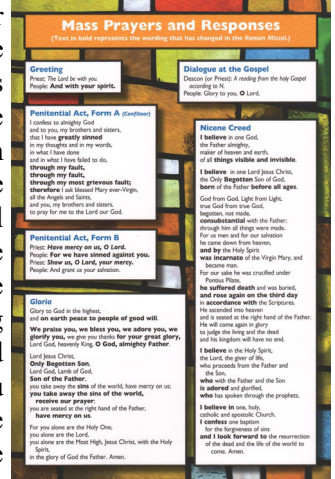
9. PRACTICE THE VIRTUES

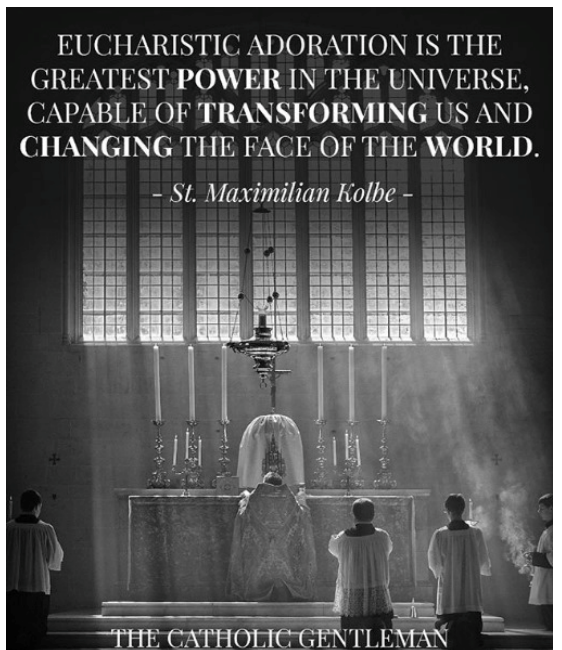
