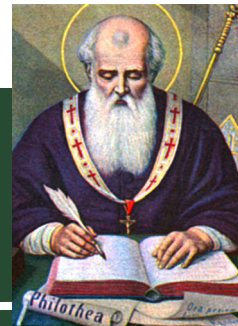

NEW CAMERA AND BUZZER

Over the past few years Catholic Mutual the insurance company for the Archdiocese has looked at the security issues of Parishes with all the litigation in our present society. We here at St. Francis have had many people involved with security issues for the Parish and School. You will notice numbers on various windows for the fire dept. as well exits that are numbered. The school has put up new cameras and a gate system as well as moving the main office to South with a buzzer to enter the building.

With all this done there was one other area that was of great concern to many groups and that was the doors of the parking lot entering the office and church area. Our children from school use rooms in the lower office area which the double doors allowed access to. More importantly with our staff becoming more concerned with anyone just walking into the three building areas (Church, Office, and Center) without notice of the Staff or others. Add to this the rise of mental struggles by the general population because of social unrest and the Pandemic we have added a buzzer and Camera to enter these three spaces during the weekdays.

The Church is still open we just need to buzz in so we know who is in the building. This helps with the safety of our children and staff as well the protection of this beautiful church which we worked so hard to restore. Again this does not change a visit to the church or office but helps us guarantee as best we can the safety of all.

OCTOBER COLLECTION OF NEW WINTER COATS FOR CHILDREN

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Human Concerns committee can only collect NEW coats, hats, scarves and gloves for children this fall. The Tree House will distribute to those most in need.

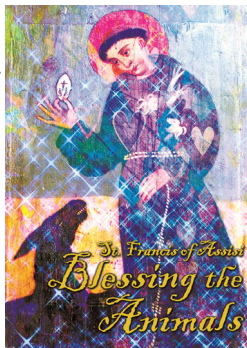

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS

We can only be Church when all are helping to minister to the community. Looking forward to seeing as many as comfortable.

DISPENSATION ENDING EXPLANATION

The dispensation to attend Sunday Mass for Catholics has expired on Sept. 14. What does the end of the dispensation really mean? These clarifications are based on the fact that St. Francis de Sales is following CDC requirements which we have worked hard to implement.

1. Those who are in their 70's, 80's and 90's need to look at their physical condition. If you are fairly healthy and feel that your immunity system is still high functioning you should attend. If there is any major or minor condition you are NOT required to return.
2. Those who are talking care of high risk members of the Family daily or weekly are also allowed to continue the dispensation.
3. Anyone of any age that has major medical issues also are dispensed from attendance at Sunday Mass
4. Fear of the corona virus is NOT grounds for the dispensation. As Catholics Fear can never be our guiding light, but Faith. That is why the angel Gabriel begins with the words to the Blessed Mother, "Be not afraid Mary!" However intelligence does play a part. If you are sick, stay away, if you were exposed stay away until the quarantine period is completed before returning (this is not sinning).
5. This Phase Two still has limitations on Servers, Ministers, other ministries and capacity in the Church. We do have the use of three spaces in the Church that allow almost 175-200 people total. If we need to add a Mass that will happen.

All other issues that come up we will respond to in the best and quickest way possible.

Finally not all groups can meet on the Parish grounds but MANY can. We still cannot have social gatherings that may attract a large group into a confined space. But a prayer group, study group, or other gathering that can keep CDC regulations will be approved through contacting the Office. We already have a few groups starting up again as will be seen in this weeks bulletin.

Hope this helps explain a little better what we can and cannot do. Thank you for your time and patience. As the Administrator/Pastor this is the hardest time in my many years as a Priest.

ADORING THE BLESSED SACRAMENT...

*It happened on the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels
~ Oct. 2*

It was during the Mass at 6:30 in the morning, at the moment of the Consecration...A blazing light suddenly shone forth...I had the feeling that this adorable splendor was that of the presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ In the Eucharist. Struck to the heart I could only repeat, 'My Lord and My God!'

At the same moment there appeared the outline of angels in prayer before the shining Host. They were kneeling all around the altar in a semi-circle, their backs toward us. There were eight of them...they did not have wings, but their bodies were enveloped in sort of a mysterious luminescence which clearly distinguished them from humans.

Amazed, not believing my eyes, I opened and closed them, rubbed them, but nothing changed. All eight were there to adore the Most Blessed Sacrament in an attitude of great devotion...

At the moment of Communion, my guardian angel approached me to invite me to advance to the altar. At that moment, I clearly distinguished the guardian angels of each member of the community close to their left shoulders, and of the height a little smaller than each. Like my guardian angel they gave truly the impression of guiding and watching over them with sweetness and affection. This scene in itself opened my eyes to the profound meaning of the guardian angel, better than any theological explanation, even the most detailed. After dinner I gave a complete account of this vision to the Bishop...Had they not chosen the Feast of the Guardian Angels to show the example of adoration and to reveal their readiness to lead us to the Lord?
