

Church Fathers Part Two

If you came to our first gathering or missed it, we invite you to join us for our second session on the Church Fathers at 6:30pm on March 23rd in the Parish Church. This time we will look at St. Irenaeus, Clement of Alexandria, Origen, St. Augustine of Hippo, St. Cyril of Jerusalem and many others who looked at such important questions as How is the Divinity and Humanity of Jesus shared when Divine and Human are opposing concepts. When we use the word Logos (Word) as Jesus is the Logos the "Word of God, what does that really mean. The word Gnostic: a term referring to a group of people who felt that as Catholics we were imbued with a special Knowledge (Gnosis) some of which is highly spiritual and prophetic. Later creating some problems between establish belief and devotional belief in the Church. These are just a few of the issues, all of which are still struggles today for the general community of believers today.

There are many ways that our feast days are placed on our liturgical calendar. Some are based on the death of a Saint, or a special day that a Saint represents in the history of the Church. Other Feast days were placed on days to offset Pagan celebrations when those lands became Catholic. One that shouts loudly is the celebration of Christmas. Most scholars realize that Jesus was probably born in the Spring time based on the stories of his birth. When certain Feast days are chosen they are based on the reality of the human cycle of Life.



This week we have one of those Feast days. Once the Western Church choose December 25th as Christmas, then two other Feasts fell into place. One being this week's Feast on March 25th "The Annunciation of the Lord" and the other based on our Blessed Mother's visit to Elizabeth after the annunciation. As the Gospel of Luke states Elizabeth was in the sixth month of her pregnancy hence June 26th is the Birth of John the Baptist. This is also why many believe the Feast of St. Joseph is March 19th on the calendar in preparation for the Annunciation.

Our Church is full of many splendid celebrations that are connected to the flow of life around us. Lent being one of those beginning in the desert of winter when the light has not fully reversed the course of nature. Finally ending with the Resurrection and new life blooming around us. What is even more interesting is that most of our feast days are solar based in timing, whereas Easter is lunar based which is why Easter varies in celebration by twenty-eight days, not being based on 365 days as most Feasts.

Consequently, as we celebrate the Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord this week take some time to reflect on the many ways our Church continues to connect everyday life and the life of the Church through Jesus as he said I make all things New. Continued with the prophecy of Isaiah that the Messiah will establish a New Heaven and a New Earth. Blessed Annunciation!





This Sunday's Gospel Jesus responds to those around him, that my hour has not yet come and in other parts of the Gospel Jesus slips out of the Temple precinct undetected. Because of this stepping out of the limelight or stepping back from His Public ministry it was common to cover the statues in the Church until the Night of the Easter Vigil when the Public life of Christ is again proclaimed in the Resurrection.

We cover the Crucifix as a reminder that the Illuminated Christ will come to Fulfillment in the Resurrection when what was hidden is now revealed as the fourth Sunday of Lents Gospel expressed that those who live in Truth come to the Light. The Paschal Candle the symbol for us as Catholics at Baptisms and Funerals of the Light of Christ guiding us into the world as through Baptism and as guiding us to the gates of Heaven as in Funerals is extinguished and removed from the Church.

These two symbolic rituals are wonderful ways as Catholics to prepare ourselves for the next two Sundays of Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday, connected by Holy Week. As you see a covered cross and an extinguished candle remember the words at the beginning of the Gospel of John and spoken during last week's Gospel, the light shines through the darkness and the darkness did not over-come it.
