

COME AND JOIN US ON THESE THREE SPECIAL DAYS OF HOLY WEEK

Holy Thursday marks the beginning of the sacred Easter Triduum, which culminates with the celebration of Easter. On this day, we remember the Last Supper, during which “Jesus, loving those who were his own in the world even to the end, offered his Body and Blood to the Father under the appearance of bread and wine, gave them to the apostles to eat and drink, then enjoined the apostles and their successors in the priesthood to offer them in turn. Based on those actions of Our Savior on this day there is an additional Mass on Holy Thursday known as the Chrism Mass in which the Holy Oils that are presented at Holy Thursdays Mass of the Last Supper are blessed followed myself as your parish Priest recommitting and dedicating my life in Service to Jesus Christ and our Parish Community Then celebrating the Mass of the Lord’s Supper, first and foremost as the memorial of the institution of the Eucharist, that is, of the Memorial of the Lord’s Passover, by which under sacramental signs he perpetuated among us the sacrifice of the New Law. The Mass of the Lord's Supper is also the memorial of the institution of the priesthood, by which Christ's mission and sacrifice are perpetuated in the world.”



On Good Friday, we recall Christ's passion and death of the Lord. It is the only day of the Church calendar on which Mass is not celebrated. I always smile when people call to ask what time Mass is Good Friday. On Good Friday Instead, we gather quietly to pray, both for ourselves and those around us; to listen to Scripture; and to venerate the cross concluding with the reception of the Body of Christ that was consecrated at the Mass of the Lord's Supper. Good Friday is also a day when there are no Sacraments celebrated, even Reconciliation. Hence Good Friday is a time to reflect on our own sinfulness and need for repentance, and it is a day in which, amid the sorrow, we show our appreciation for Christ's loving sacrifice. Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

The *Missale Romanum* reminds us that the **Easter Vigil** is the “mother of all vigils,” the “greatest and most noble of all solemnities.” The past many years as a Priest I have always looked forward to this glorious and wonderful Vigil. Unfortunately, because of its time, beginning after sunset (8:00pm this year.) and length, from and hour and a half to two hours, many Catholics never get to experience the wonder and magnificence of that night. This year because of many ritual parts being shorten based on lack of a Catechumen it will be shorter. On this night, the Church keeps watch as we begin in darkness with all lights off in the Church, then the lighting of the fire and the blessing of the Paschal Candle which is used at all our Baptisms and Funerals during the coming year, multiple readings celebrating the creation of the world leading to the resurrection of Christ in the sacraments and awaiting his return in glory. As an essential part of the Vigil the community recites their Baptismal Promises as a recommitment to the Body of Christ. It is the turning point of the Triduum, the Passover of the new covenant, which marks Christ's passage from death to life. The waters of Baptism are also Blessed with the plunging of the Paschal Candle our symbol of Christ into the womb of New Life, the Baptismal Font. Through Baptism we are born into the Kingdom of God here on earth through the removal of Original Sin which separates us from God and his people.

REFLECTION FOR HOLY WEEK

Ask yourself: What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me? Then from the story of the disciples untying the colt for Jesus to enter Jerusalem

on Palm Sunday, ask: and if anyone should ask you, "Why are you untying it?" as Jesus said you will answer, "The Master has need of it." When have I been challenged about living my faith? How do I respond to those challenges? Another moment to reflect on is that when the whole multitude of his disciples began to praise God aloud with joy for all the mighty deeds they had seen. Ask what good works has God accomplished in me during this Lenten season? How have I seen God working in my life and in the lives of those around me? Finally reflect on Jesus' proclamation about his disciples: "I tell you, if they keep silent, the stones will cry out!" When am I silent when I should speak out? How can I be more attentive to the voice of God? Concluding after a period of silent reflection and/or discussion with family or friends, recite the Lord's Prayer and ask for God's grace to follow in the footsteps of the Apostles: meaning those who are sent.



SERVING THE SUFFERING CHRIST As we enter Holy Week and celebrate Palm Sunday, let's reflect on how our Lord suffered from our indifference: those who proclaimed him king of Jerusalem were the same who called to crucify him. We recognize we are all one human family. Are we contributing to the suffering



of our sisters and brothers with our indifference to their realities? How does our faith inspire us to care for them and share the gifts that God has bestowed on us? Our community changed lives this Lent, and CRS Rice Bowl wants to say THANK YOU! 

SEMANA SANTA: Todas nuestras celebraciones de Semana Santa serán bilingües con el P. Gil y el P. Bernardo, quienes ayudan a servir a nuestra comunidad hispana, se unen a nosotros para estas maravillosas celebraciones. Solo un recordatorio de que debido a las restricciones de Covid-19 que todavía están vigentes para la Semana Santa según lo indicado por la Arquidiócesis, los rituales como el "Lavado de pies" serán eliminados para la comunidad en general. Las presentaciones de los óleos se colocarán en la zona del Altar el Jueves Santo. La Veneración de la Cruz el Viernes Santo tiene dos formas ofrecidas por la Arquidiócesis, ninguna de las cuales permite besar o tocar la Cruz. En consecuencia, una forma tiene a toda la comunidad venerando desde los bancos en el mismo momento en el tiempo. El otro tiene acomodadores que dirigen a las personas que se acerquen a un área que será marcada y que hagan una genuflexión o se inclinen desde la distancia. Nos inclinamos por la segunda forma. Esos detalles serán resueltos por nuestro Comité de Liturgia. Finalmente, la Vigilia Pascual estará limitada en algunos de sus rituales. En parte por la falta de Catecúmeno esta Vigilia por no poder reunirse de verdad. También hemos agregado una misa adicional el domingo de Pascua. Lo mantendremos informado sobre todos los cambios y planes. Esperamos que todos sigan teniendo una maravillosa temporada de Cuaresma.
